For [HANNAH MONTANA](#):

- **Send an invitation in the shape of an I-Pod, and provide all of the party details on the I-Pod Invitation. Definitely state that Hannah Montana music will be featured!**
- **Let the kids take to the party stage and perform songs with the karaoke machine as individuals, or you can split the group into two groups and they can practice a performance together and perform in front of the other.**
- **Give the kids the opportunity to get dressed up for their Hannah Montana performance. Provide hair spray, brushes, hair clips, lip gloss, blush, etc. for the kids to get ready. If there are boys at the party, they can also comb their hair and look cool with tattoos.**

For [HIGH SCHOOL MUSICAL](#):

- **Send out your party details either in the shape of a theater ticket or as a VIP Pass into the party. Make sure to use theatrical lingo and to request that the guests bring their tickets or VIP passes to the party to get into the main stage fun.**
- **The main activity of the party will be performing either as a whole group or as a competition of smaller groups. If you want different groups to perform then break down the large group into teams of 3-4 kids to work together to perform a musical act.**
- **Serve popcorn, nachos, large pretzels, hot dogs, mini-pizzas with an array of toppings, candy bars, soda. Just think of all of those great food items at your high school cafeteria, and these should match the theme perfectly.**
